Change is Coming!

We have recently added a new level (Aqua) to our curriculum. This is to help our students with a smoother transition between our intermediate and advance levels. Our efforts to improve your experience will not stop there. Effective September 2nd, SSTA will make these additional improvements to our swim school policy. Parents will no longer be limited to only 1 free class change per month, and as a result the \$20 fee will also be removed. We will also be streamlining our prices across the board. If you currently do not have classes in Monday classes, this change will not affect you in any way. In addition, all of our intermediate levels; white, yellow, navy, green & aqua will be adjusted from 1:4 to 1:5. This adjustment is reasonably being coordinated to accommodate with the maturity level, skills, and attention span of these intermediate levels. In addition, this will allow parent with more than one child to be easier find class times to better fit their schedules. If you have any questions, please feel free to speak to our front desk or a deck supervisor.

Progress Reports

August 18th –August 24th, all instructors will be handing out progress reports to their swimmers. These reports are intended to inform you of how your child is doing with the skills that are currently being taught for the level they are in.
