

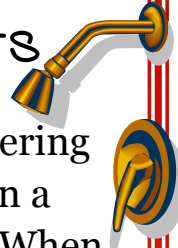

We are pleased to announce that we have started implementing our newest level Aqua into our curriculum. This level serves as a stepping stone after level Green, and before level Blue. Over the past two years, over the past two years we have studied and observed our students progression in our school. We realized that our original Green level was packed with great information and skills however, it was a bit too much for some kids to meet the required skills. In order to maximize the learning curve, and focus on the skills that match the physical development, this will help our students to focus and understand the fundamentals of the strokes being learned a little easier. The new Aqua level Butterfly (kick & swim), Breaststroke (kick), along with continuing to revise Free Style, Backstroke and introduce proper flip turns. We believe that with this new level, our students will strive through our curriculum in a much smoother pace.
